Malawi is now in the rainy season.

The farmers are already planting their crops and now need sustained but not heavy rain to enable them to have a good harvest next year.

The 2023/2024 rainfall season is expected to be somewhat uncertain, according to the Malawi Meteorological Services, as they will be influenced by El Niño conditions.

Normal total rainfall amounts are expected over most areas of the country during the season but, in November it was below average, particularly in southern and northern Malawi.

In January 2024 it is likely to be above-normal and there is also a high chance of prolonged dry spells in the month of February 2024.
