The labourers are doing a fantastic job and now the first midwife house and the teachers house for Everlands are nearing completion. Just a few things need to be done before they can be occupied.

The maternity wing is also near to completion with painting being done but we still require the power to be installed.

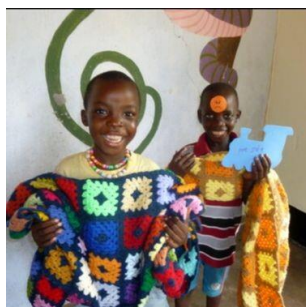


This photo shows the teachers house on the left and midwife house on the right and This is the maternity wing entrance and side view.

There is a price reduction this year and we will be charging £225 per cubic metre not £250.

The best items to send are clothes, blankets, school stationery and sports equipment. The families in Malawi receive this with great gratitude to you, as life is very tough, especially after a 44% devaluation in the Malawi currency, the kwacha.
