At the end of July, a team from Mission Direct will be continuing to work on the construction of the school. This year they will be painting the second classroom, which in September will be used by the children in Std 3 and 4.

This will greatly assist the community and will relieve the pressure of the primary school at Ngolowindo that has over 2500 students!

The Headteacher at Moyo is so pleased with the partnership between Starfish and Mission Direct as it is enabling the education to be improved in the community.

When the team are in Malawi, they will also be giving the main building at Glad Tidings an uplift, by painting the exterior walls and the internal corridors to make it lighter inside.
