The UK team have returned safely from another amazing trip to Malawi. The time there was really well spent visiting our projects, linked schools, charity partners and of course the spending time with the incredible Malawi staff team.

- Seeing Hope Clinic in full flow was inspiring. The clinic staff team are doing so well attending to over 4000 general outpatients a month. The clinic is building up a very good reputation in the community and surrounding area.
 - The Maternity wing construction is growing at a pace and will soon have floors laid.
 - The four nurseries are making a difference to the children's early years education and the team were impressed by the level of teaching.
 - The welcome that we had in the many schools that we visited was overwhelming.

- Bible Explorer is reaching thousands of children a year and we were privileged to watch a class in session. It was inspiring.
