CHILDREN'S WORK 2021 MID YEAR REPORT

The programme is there to help children know God and learn what the Bible says about them and what it says about God and his love for the children. It also helps them to make informed decisions after going through the lessons offered in the programme. It offers a safe zone to learn and to play with other children. Currently there are 14 centres with 45 volunteers working in the project. The programme targets children from 4 to 16 years of age and also the parents of the children who attend the activities in the centres.

The clubs meet once a week at the following centres: Gwirize, Mkonkha, Rashidi, Lifuwu, Gaga, Msangu Takomana, Katerera, Mtemeiti, Malapa, G.T.O.C, Chapita, Kaputu and Katitima. The activities rolled out are bible lessons, playing football and netball, games, singing and praying.
